Introduction of new technologies

- Early 1980s: the Minitel
- Mid 1990s: cell phones
- Early 2000s: blogs

[Skyblogs]

- Started becoming popular in 2003
- Use “SMS language”
- Measure blogger popularity
 - “friends” and “comments”
- Allow for communities to form
- Were a precursor to social networks like MySpace

[Adolescent video sharing today]

French teenagers

- Are comfortable with new technologies and Web 2.0
- Live simultaneously in two worlds
 - Analog
 - Digital
- Are encouraged by their government to use technology

[Tecktonic killer phenomenon]

Offline

- Involves dance battles between youths
- Is set to techno music
- Is performed by a certain group



Online

- Generates an active video sharing community
- Transfers blogging skills to new environment
- Can use tags to advertise/share videos effectively

User communities and tags

Literature search yielded little

- ✘ Social tagging in France
- 1 Articles in French journals about social tagging

Case study: Tecktonik killer video postings

- 12 video postings selected
 - 3 host sites
 - 4 categories of videos
- Criteria
 - Clearly homemade
 - Encourage community interaction

Discussion

Description of tags for the 12 videos

- 28 unique tags, plus personal names/affiliations
 - 13 variants of tags for the named dance
 - 7 tags using English-language terms, not TCK-related

Number of tags per video (n=77)

Parodies	12 tags
Serious videos	4-5 tags

Total average	6-7 tags

[Proposed future studies]

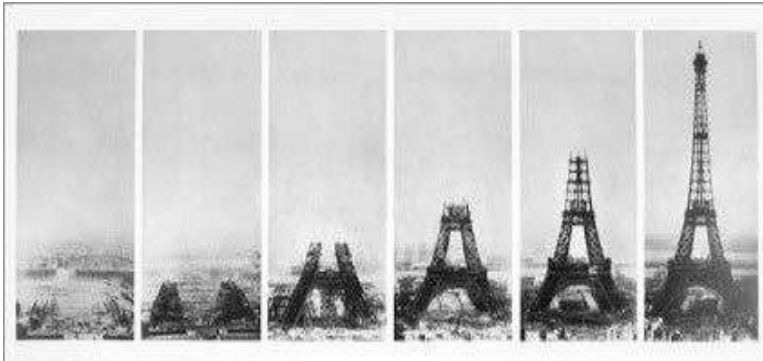
